


Do you know what a prism is?




A prism is a glass bar that separates white light into the colors of the rainbow

Do you know what the purpose of a balance is?




A balance is a tool that measures the mass of an object.

Do you know for what purpose a microscope is used?





A microscope is a tool that magnifies objects by increasing the power of magnification.
