


First, have students study the flash cards that have the weather symbol and the meaning. They can quiz the members of their group. Work together!

After they have mastered the list, have students print off two copies of the cards and play memory.
















There are four seasons. Winter, spring, summer, and fall. How do you think the trees change during the seasons? Label the trees winter, spring, summer, and fall.
