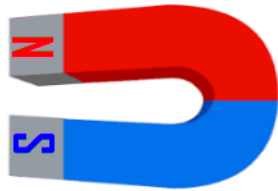


**There are many

Magnets can attract or repel metals.

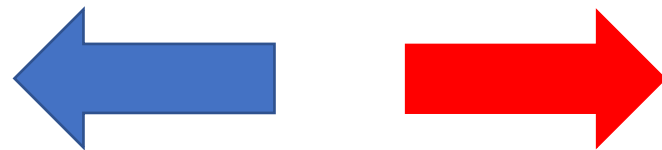
Attract means to pull together.



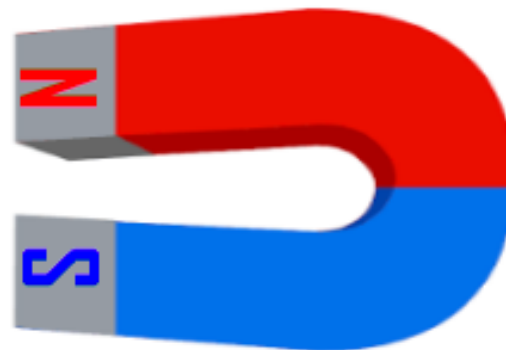
This is a circle magnet.
